

AEROMEXICO LAUNCHES MEXICO CITY-CHETUMAL ROUTE

- *The company will have more than 130 weekly flights to Cancun and Chetumal from Mexico City, Monterrey, Guadalajara, and Tijuana.*

Mexico City, December 9, 2020.- Upon the arrival of Aeromexico first flight of its new route Mexico City-Chetumal, the Governor of the State of Quintana Roo, Carlos Joaquin Gonzalez, together with other local airport authorities from *Aeropuertos y Servicios Auxiliares (ASA)* and the airline representatives, received the aircraft with the traditional water salute to celebrate this new launch.

Aeromexico will be operating a daily flight to the capital of Quintana Roo, and together with those served to Cancun, will add an offer of 130 weekly frequencies to the state.

"I am very pleased with the arrival of this flight to Chetumal that without a doubt is key for the economic reactivation of the state since it will increase connectivity, and at the same time will help us improve hotel occupancy levels. The route will allow us to continue carrying out actions in favor of tourism and economic development in the capital of our state, and going to generate greater investment in the southern area of Quintana Roo. We continue to move forward with a firm step," said the Governor.

For his part, Hugo Alberto Delgado Ortega, Technical and Consulting Director of *Aeropuertos y Servicios Auxiliares (ASA)* representing Oscar Argüello Ruiz, General Director of ASA, said: "for the launch of the new route Mexico City-Chetumal, operated by Aeromexico, the Chetumal International Airport has a new terminal building that increases its capacity to 100%, to attend 370 passengers during peak hours, reaching the optimum IATA level, with 10m2 per passenger, thus offering a better quality service".

"We will continue to meet our commitment to serving the routes and destinations that our customers demand, and the State of Quintana Roo offers an ideal infrastructure for business and tourism. We are very proud to fly even more to this State" said Giancarlo Mulinelli, Senior Vice President of Global Sales for Aeromexico.
