Mexico City, May 19, 2022.- Aeromexico expands its connectivity network to and from the metropolitan area of the Valley of Mexico so the customers can choose the airport that fits their travel plans, either using the International Airport Felipe Angeles (AIFA) or the International Airport of Mexico City (AICM). Due to the growth in its fleet, Mexico's Global Airline will perform these new flights.

With the above, during August the offer will be close to 50,000 seats, which represents an increase of over 400% compared to the current offer.

The airline will add Veracruz as a ninth destination in the second half of September, and three routes will have increased frequencies. Thus, Aeromexico will be carrying out 900 monthly arrival and departure operations from AIFA with a monthly offer of more than 100 thousand seats.

With the new flights, Aeromexico will operate 51 routes in the domestic market, maintaining the industry's highest safety and service standards.
