# **AEROMEXICO RESUMES SERVICE TO NICARAGUA**

• The airline will have an offer of three weekly flights.

**Nicaragua, July 1, 2021.-** Aeromexico resumed its service to Augusto C. Sandino International Airport in Managua, where its first flight was received with the traditional water cannon salute. The route will have three weekly flights operating on Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Saturdays, departing from Mexico City.

The airline has been connecting Nicaragua with Mexico for more than six years; one of the most diverse countries in the world due to its culture, history, beaches, gastronomy, Mariachi music, and its internationally recognized celebrations such as the Day of the Dead. In addition, it is the Latin American country with the largest UNESCO World Heritage sites, such as Chichen Itza, in Yucatan, or the Historic Center of Oaxaca.

Shantanny Anasha Campbell Lewis, Minister of Tourism of Nicaragua, affirmed that "this restart of Aeromexico's commercial operations demonstrates the confidence in our country and contributes to the efforts that the Government has been making in favor of the tourism recovery in Nicaragua".

Also, Giancarlo Mulinelli, Aeromexico's Global Sales Senior Vice President, added: "At Aeromexico, we are pleased with the return of our flights to Nicaragua, a country rich in culture, tourism, and architecture. We recognize the work that is done every day, hand in hand with all the tourism sector destination representatives, and thanks to that today, Nicaragua joins the reactivation of our international flights, which we will continue to increase gradually to offer more and better options to our clients".

Aeromexico reaffirmed its commitment to continue to connect Mexico with Central America, where it currently offers service to five destinations from Mexico City and an offer of more than 42,500 monthly seats. Specifically to Nicaragua, the airline will offer more than 2,700 monthly seats on flights operated with Embraer 190 aircraft.
