

## DELTA AND AEROMEXICO PLAN MORE THAN 4,300 FLIGHTS IN DECEMBER BETWEEN THE UNITED STATES AND MEXICO

- *Both airlines will cover more than 45 routes between both countries.*
- *With this increase, the carriers will have recovered 95% of their offer in available seat kilometers.*

**Mexico City, November 19, 2020.-** During the month of December, Delta Air Lines and its partner Aeromexico will operate more than 4,300 flights between the United States and Mexico, which represents a 95% recovery in available seat kilometers (ASK) compared to the same month of 2019.

Since May 2017, when its Joint Cooperation Agreement (JCA) was launched, both airlines have focused on creating synergies to offer their customers a seamless experience, along with a wide connectivity network in the transborder market.

Of the more than 45 routes planned for the holiday season, the following stand out:

Delta routes:

- **Atlanta:** Cancun, Mexico City, Guadalajara, Monterrey, Los Cabos, and Puerto Vallarta.
- **Detroit:** Cancun, Los Cabos, and Mexico City.
- **Los Angeles:** Cancun, Mexico City, Guadalajara, Los Cabos, and Puerto Vallarta.
- **Minneapolis-St Paul:** Cancun, Los Cabos, and Puerto Vallarta.
- **New York:** Cancun, Los Cabos, and Mexico City.
- **Salt Lake City:** Cancun, Mexico City, Guadalajara, Los Cabos, and Puerto Vallarta.
- **Seattle:** Cancun and Los Cabos.

Additional Cancun service offered from Boston, Cincinnati, and Raleigh-Durham

Aeromexico routes:

- **Mexico City:** Chicago, Denver, Houston, Los Angeles, Las Vegas, Orlando, San Antonio, Miami, New York, San Francisco, and celebrates its service resumption to Seattle.
- **Guadalajara:** Chicago, Fresno, Los Angeles, San Francisco, and Sacramento.

Both carriers developed robust action plans to protect the health of their customers and employees in all their operations. Delta implemented the Delta CareStandard, while Aeromexico created its Health and Sanitization Management System (HSMS), both comprised of measures and protocols based on the highest standards in the airline industry.
